

CHILD SEXUAL EXPLOITATION

Victims of sexual exploitation are often unaware that they are being exploited. This type of abuse could happen to any child or young person up to the age of 18 from ANY background. Signs of sexual exploitation can range significantly but there are a number of tell tale signs you should look out for in a child or young person:

- · Changes in eating patterns
- · Chatting online to strangers
- Misusing alcohol or drugs
- Appearing to have new unexplained gifts
- Secretive mobile phone or computer use sometimes at unsociable hours
- · Mood swings or emotionally upset
- · Spending a lot of time and associating with an older person away from home
- Showing inappropriate sexual behaviour
- Suffering from sexually transmitted infections
- Regularly missing school or not taking part in education
- · Missing for long periods of time or coming home late




